BACKGROUND

Known to be the leading winery in the renaissance of Morocco's wine industry, the vineyards of Thalvin - Domaine Ouled Thaleb, are located in Zenata, the coastal region of Morocco. Enhanced by the warm rays of the Moroccan sun, the constitution of its soil, the use of sustainable farming methods and the handpicking of the grapes. The resulting traditional winemaking approach has led to the creation of the best of Moroccan wines, and provide a diverse range of wines, each created with a stylistic approach, unique blends and settled notes.



GRAPES

100% Syrah

VINEYARD

AOG Zenata Grapes coming from the prestigious Rommani Vineyards, an area of rolling hills with dark black clay soil called Tirs. Vinified and bottled at the Domaine Ouled Thaleb in Benslimane. All vineyards are ploughed and weeded by hand and no herbicide or fungicide treatments are used.

WINEMAKING

Fermentation occurs in concrete tanks.

AGEING

Aged in 1/3 new Francois Freres oak barrels for 12 months.

TASTING NOTES

Red ruby color. Slight gamy/bacon edge to wild berry fruit and smoky spice. Lifted and quite fresh. In the mouth the wine shows blackberry and spice with moderate tannins, moderate acidity and well integrated oak. Finishes fresh and lively.

Between 60°F (16 °C) and 64°F (18 °C)
